 - Easy integration into an IdP
 - Uses existing Shibboleth arp.site.xml



 - Displayed only once
- Attribute Release Information stored in a database
 - ASCII File
 - JDBC (MySql)
 - o SQL statements are configurable
- Logging of provider accesses
 - **Can be enabled, disabled or encrypted**
- Default language and all texts are configurable
- Disable Global Consent Option
- Blacklist of providerId's
 - Should only be used in exceptional circumstances
