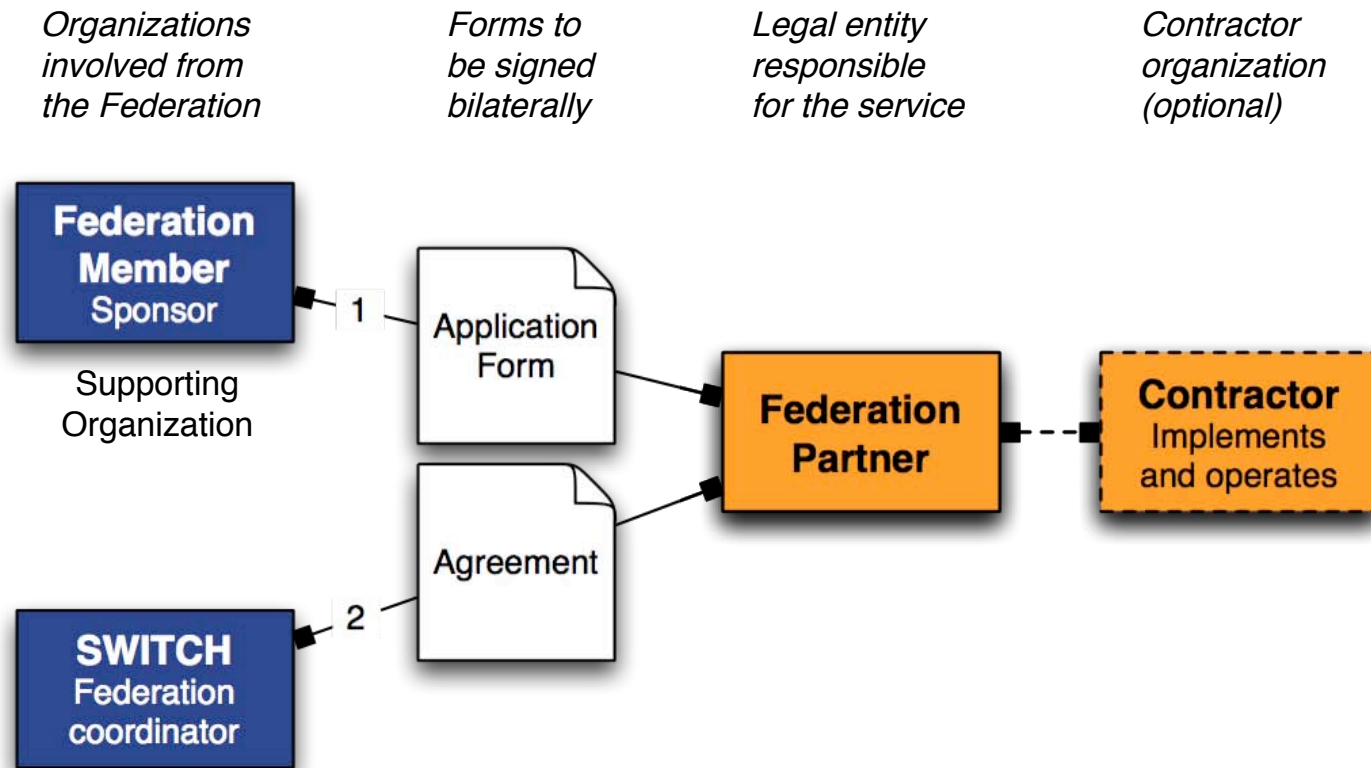

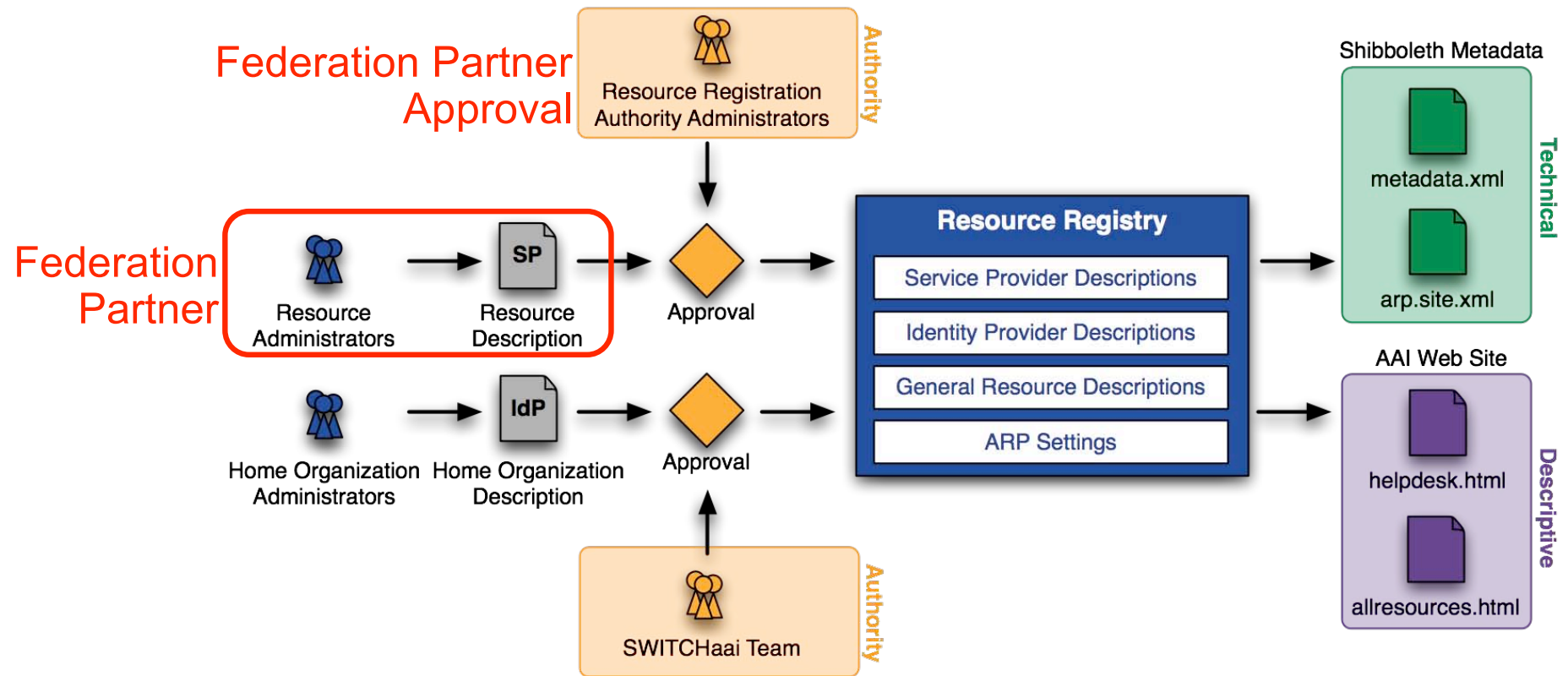
How to become Federation Partner?

Duties of the Supporting Organization

- RRA Admin responsible to approve Federation Partner SPs
 - Check attribute requirements
 - Check intended audience



Duties of all IdP admins regarding new SPs

- Review Attribute Requirements of new SPs
 - Questions?
 - Ask the SP admin or RRA admin
 - Define 'Specific Attribute Release Policy'
- Consider **uApprove**
 - It implements user consent (*formerly known as ArpViewer*)
 - Supports blacklist configuration for
 - SPs
 - attributes

IdP admin can opt-out new SP

- New SP added to the federation
 - SP admin defines intended audience
 - IdP admin gets notified on newly added SP
 - IdP admins can opt-out
- Why not opt-in?
 - Scales badly
 - SP admin has to convince IdP admins to opt-in
 - Causes additional work load at IdP admins
 - Less reliable service for end users
